The ideal candidate will have demonstrated leadership in cooperatively creating and delivering organization-wide diversity and equity programs; the proven ability to establish effective partnerships with community members, organizations, and government entities; and the ability to communicate effectively with all stakeholders and to engage with and incorporate the voices of students and student groups, particularly those who have been marginalized.
