will interface primarily with an external audience to create pipeline opportunities for growth domestically and abroad. They will travel where necessary to grow UB's reputation and resources to drive innovation on campus and throughout the region.

The incumbent will launch new initiatives to drive the growth of collaborative resources to support the growth of WNY. The innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystems will create new and leverage existing entrepreneurship resources, including state-of-the-art facilities, start-up programs, accelerators, incubators, EIRs, and other services to support innovation in fields such as life sciences, advanced materials, biotech, artificial intelligence, and emerging technologies for UB innovators and the greater WNY community.
