operational coordination across all of the collaborative entities, including UB's faculty and research administration, the Economic Development Organizations (EDOs), the Manufacturing Extension Partnership organizations (MEPs), industry partners, and public sector entities.

- Manage engagement for the SCAN project to ensure that all deliverables are achieved.

- Organize events and conferences to connect thought leaders, industry experts, and students around emerging trends in supply chain analytics.
