It has evolved into a nationally recognized, selective public liberal arts college with undergraduate and graduate programs of study. SUNY Geneseo is proud of its status as New York State's sole member of the Council of Public Liberal Arts Colleges (COPLAC).

As part of its liberal arts mission, Geneseo prepares its students to become responsible and engaged citizens who can assist the communities in which they live to become more diverse and inclusive, more globally aware, and more sustainable. The Genesee Valley is considered the jewel of Geneseo, with stunning landscapes of rolling hills, expansive vistas and lush farmlands. Located in the beautiful Finger Lakes region of western NY, the scenic beauty offers a variety of year-round outdoor activities like hiking, skiing, fishing and other sports enjoyed in the surrounding lakes region.

In addition to local cafés, farmers' markets, and unique shops, Geneseo's location offers easy day trips to Niagara Falls; Toronto, Ontario; Buffalo, NY; and Rochester, NY.
