This role drives fundraising to support programming and create new opportunities. This role is integral to advancing the mission of the College of Human Sciences through programming and initiatives of the Cary Center. This role will also include teaching responsibilities and may carry an assistant/associate clinical professor title. *This a twelve-month nontenure track position.* The candidate selected must be able to meet eligibility requirements to work in the United States at the time the appointment is scheduled to begin and continue working legally during employment.

Key Responsibilities:

Leadership and Management:

- Provide effective leadership, guidance, and support of strategic initiatives.
- Supervise a team of employees, ensuring alignment with organizational goals and standards of excellence.
