Develops focus areas in preparation for presidential and other senior level visits.
- Work closely with the Vice President for University Advancement and colleagues within the Division of University Advancement, as well as deans, faculty, and key volunteers within UB's schools/units to pursue a coordinated and strategic program of cultivation, solicitation and stewardship of major gift prospects and donors.
